## <u>City Employment for Appointed Mayors</u> (working title only, subject to change)

## The Way It Is Now:

The San Francisco Charter provides that if the Office of Mayor becomes vacant, the Board of Supervisors may appoint a successor. The appointed mayor serves until a new mayor elected by the voters takes office.

A local ethics law prohibits any former mayor from receiving an appointment to any fulltime, paid City position, for one year after leaving office.

## The Proposal:

Proposition \_\_\_\_\_ would add an exception allowing an appointed mayor to accept a fulltime, paid City position without waiting for one year, as long as the appointed mayor has not run for election to keep the office.

**A "YES" Vote Means:** If you vote "yes," you want to allow an appointed mayor to accept a full-time, paid City job at any time after leaving office, provided that he or she does not seek election to that office.

A "NO" Vote Means: If you vote "no," you do not want to make this change.
