Hello...

I am Larry Bush and would respectfully appeal the Ballot Simplification Committee's description of the **Charter Amendment: Amending Initiative Ordinances and Policy Declarations.**

I would recommend two changes.

First, I believe it is more accurate and informative to the voters to state this is "Amending or Repealing Initiative Ordinances and Policy Statements"

The proposed language is not limited to amending, and I believe that voters who look only at the title will not realize that this measure, if approved, would permit the outright repeal of measures approved by voters.

Second, I believe this language is confusing: "The Board may place measures on the ballot by a majority vote of its members at a public meeting." It is my understanding that it requires a majority vote of ALL its members and not just those who attend the public meeting. A literal view of the current draft language could mean that fewer than six Board members in favor could approve a measure for the ballot.

I believe this should read "by a majority of all its members and taking place at a public meeting" to clarify that this requires six votes.
