## THE WAY IT IS NOW:

In November 2004, San Francisco voters adopted a policy urging the United

States government to withdraw all troops from Iraq and bring all military

personnel back to the United States.

## THE PROPOSAL:

Proposition \_\_\_\_\_ is a declaration of policy that the United States Senate and

House of Representatives should vote against any further funding for the

deployment of United States Armed Forces in Iraq, except for funds specifically

earmarked to provide for the safe and orderly withdrawal of troops in Iraq.

A "YES" VOTE MEANS: If you vote "yes," you want it to be City policy that the

United States should stop funding the deployment of armed forces in Iraq, except

for funds for the withdrawal of troops.

A "NO" VOTE MEANS: If you vote "no," you do not want the City to adopt this policy.
