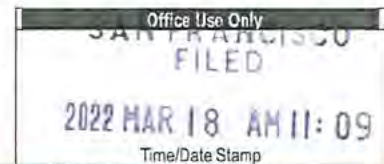

We acknowledge residents are frustrated and angry about crime, but we reject the premise that keeping the public safe means abandoning our values. 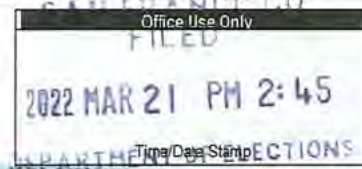
