His reckless and often impulsive decisions to prematurely release criminal offenders back onto our streets endanger public safety without accomplishing any meaningful reform of our criminal justice system. Unlike his predecessors Kamala Harris and George Gascón, Chesa Boudin has not developed any new, innovative programs to rehabilitate criminal offenders or prevent crime other than those already mandated by law.
