Application for Voter Registration Information

Voter registration information is confidential and may not be disclosed except as authorized by law (California Elections Code sections 2188, 2194; California Government Code section 6254.4). Voter registration information may be provided to a candidate for office, a ballot measure committee, or other persons for election, scholarly, journalistic, political, or governmental purposes as determined by the California Secretary of State. All requests for voter registration information must be accompanied by written application.

Permissible Uses and Supporting Documentation

Your application for voter registration information must specify the information you are requesting and how you intend to use that information. In the future, if you request information to be used for a different purpose, you must submit a new application. In order to qualify to receive confidential voter information, you must submit supporting documentation in the form of identification and written authorization, and your request must meet one of the following purposes (*Please select one*):

- Election Purposes: Voter registration information must be made available to anyone authorized on behalf of a candidate, campaign committee, political party, or non-profit organization for any election. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation include written authorization on letterhead from the candidate, or a committee board member.
- O Political Purposes: Voter registration information must be made available to anyone authorized on behalf of vendors providing information to candidates, campaign committees, or political parties regarding specific political issues. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation include written authorization on letterhead from the candidate, or a committee board member.
- O Scholarly Research: Voter registration information must be made available to students and professors conducting research regarding voting, registration patterns, trends, etc. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation from students include written authorization from the advising professor. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation from professors include written authorization on institution letterhead.
- O **Journalistic**: Voter registration information must be made available to members of the press. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation include press credentials.
- Governmental Purposes: Voter registration information must be made available to applicable government agencies. Examples of acceptable supporting documentation include government credentials and written authorization on agency letterhead.

If one of the above purposes does not describe your request, you are not authorized to access confidential voter registration information.

- Willful violation of these provisions is a misdemeanor pursuant to California Elections Code section 18109. I further agree, subject to
 provisions of Title 2, Division 7, Article 1, Sections 19001 through 19007 of the California Administrative Code, to pay the State of California,
 as compensation for any unauthorized use of each individual's registration information, an amount equal to the sum of \$.50 multiplied by the
 number of times each registration record is used by the applicant in an unauthorized manner."
