## REG BSC 3-1-22 Victims and Witness Rights Reconsideration Request DP 220302

I hereby request reconsideration of the Approved Digest for the ballot measure with the working title "Victims and Witness Rights". I have included the text adopted by the Committee with my alternate language as tracked changes. I recommend these changes to increase accuracy and clarity. Thanks. DP

The Way It Is Now: The City San Francisco-provides services to victims of violent and nonviolent crime, survivors of sexual violence, and victims of gender-based violence and discrimination through various many agencies and departments.

**The Proposal:** Proposition \_ <u>is an ordinance that</u> would create an Office of Victim and Witness Rights (Office) as a new City department. The Office would provide or coordinate existing services for victims and witnesses of <u>crime all types of crimes</u>. <u>The Mayor would appoint the Director of the Office</u>.

The Office would introduce an ordinance establishing a one-year pilot program to provide free legal services for domestic violence victims, starting by July 1, 2023.

The Office would seek to establish a permanent program to provide free legal services for domestic violence victims, subject to further legislation. <u>Under these programs, a The-domestic violence victim who must</u> either <u>lives reside</u> in the City or <u>is be-the victim of a domestic violence incident that occurred in the City would be eligible for free legal services</u>.

**A "YES" Vote Means:** If you vote "yes," you want to create an Office of Victim and Witness Rights to that would provide or coordinate existing City services for victims and witnesses of crime and seek to establish programs to that provide free legal services for domestic violence victims.

A "NO" Vote Means: If you vote "no," you do not want to make these changes establish this Office.
