Dear Property Owner,

The San Francisco Board of Supervisors recently passed a Resolution of Intent to renew and expand the Castro Community Benefit District (Castro CBD). The Castro CBD's current cleaning, public safety and neighborhood advocacy services will expire on December 31, 2020 if the Castro CBD is not renewed now.

The proposed renewal and expansion of the Castro CBD will enable the Castro CBD's cleaning and advocacy services to continue, thus enabling the Castro CBD to continue keeping the Castro & Upper Market clean, pedestrian friendly and vibrant. A renewal will also allow for the Castro CBD to continue its advocacy work on behalf of the neighborhood, raising non-assessment dollars to fund other services such as public safety and economic vitality strategies.
