SUBJECT: Tourism Improvement District Ballot Tabulation

The ballots of the proposed Tourism Improvement District (District) were opened and recorded by the Department of Elections following a public hearing held on September 13, 2022 at 3:00p.m. in the Board's Legislative Chambers located on the Second floor of City Hall, One Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, California. Per the District Management Plan, the Office of the Treasurer & Tax Collector assigned a weight equivalent to the estimated assessment in Year One of the District (Assessment) to each hotel and short-term residential rental host that received a ballot, and tabulated the weight for the ballots that were submitted and not withdrawn as per the attached Department of Elections ballot report.

Per the Department of Elections, 575 ballots were returned with a vote indicated. 145 ballots were marked "yes" and 430 ballots were marked "no". Seven ballots had no box checked.

Is there a Majority Protest?

Do the total weighted NO votes exceed 50% of the proposed Assessment?

Total estimated assessments in the District for Year One: \$34,169,152.85

Total weighted YES votes, on whether to form the District and levy the Assessments:

\$22,484,898.51, 65.80% of the proposed Assessment.

Total weighted NO votes, on whether to form the District and levy the Assessments:

\$1,512,312.29, 4.43% of the proposed Assessment.
