- Gain community service hours and organizing experience
- Be involved in a distinguished program to highlight your college application
- Receive a Certificate of Honor signed by SF Mayor London Breed

## Requirements

- Must be enrolled in a San Francisco High School
- Obtain permission from parent/guardian
- Attend a 2-hour training presentation at City Hall and receive your election materials
- **Submit a completed application online by September 9**

## What are my main goals as a High School Ambassador?

- Pre-register eligible 16 or 17 years old
- Register eligible 18 years old to vote
- Recruit High School Poll Workers
- Conduct at least 1 outreach event
