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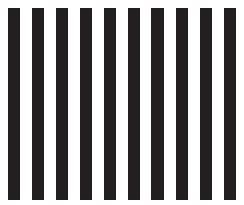

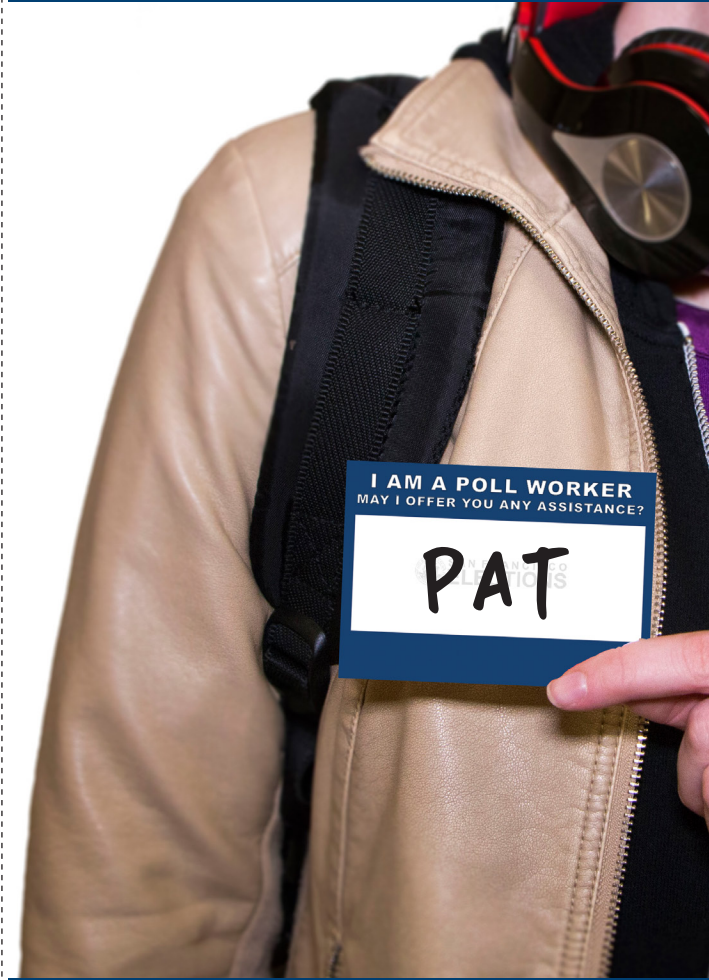

# HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT POLL WORKER APPLICATION

As a High School Student Poll Worker, you will be serving San Francisco voters and joining the team that makes Election Day happen while earning money!

## Why serve as a Poll Worker?

- Earn a stipend of \$180
- Learn about the election process first hand
- Improve your college application
- Obtain community service hours

## What are the requirements?

- Be available on Election Day, November 5, from 6 a.m. through 9 p.m.
- Be 16 years or older by Election Day
- Obtain permission from parents and teachers
- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5
- Submit a completed application by Wednesday, October 9

## What are the duties on Election Day?

- Help open a polling place at 6 a.m.
- Assist voters throughout Election Day
- Help close the polling place until the duties are complete. (approx. 9 p.m.).

## What happens after I apply?

If your application is accepted, the Department will notify you by letter or email. Successful applicants will need to attend a two and a half-hour training class.

## Can I earn extra money if I speak another language?

Yes! If you are fluent in Spanish, Cantonese, Mandarin, Filipino, Korean, or Vietnamese you can earn an extra \$20. You will need to complete our online bilingual training course.

## When will I receive my stipend?

Checks will go out at the end of November.
