

## Accessible Vote-by-Mail System A Service for Voters with Disabilities



Voters with disabilities can now access and mark a ballot in a screen-readable format from any computer with internet access. Marked ballots must be printed and returned to the Department of Elections by mail or in person.



You must be registered as a vote-by-mail voter to access your ballot through the Accessible Vote-by-Mail System. If you are not already a vote-by-mail voter, apply by October 29 at **sfelections.org/vbm** or call (415) 554-4375 or TTY: (415) 554-4386.



You may access your ballot between October 7 and Election Day, November 5 (until 8 p.m.) at **sfelections.org/access**.
