Access Your Official Ballot Online

 **What** The Accessible Vote-by-Mail (AVBM) System lets all voters access and mark a ballot from any computer with internet access. The AVBM system is compatible with assistive technology such as screen readers, head-pointers, and sip and puffs to enable all voters can vote privately and independently. Once a ballot is marked and printed, it can be returned to the Department of Elections by mail or in person.

 **How** Voters can access their ballots at **sfelections.org/access** by inputting their house number, ZIP code, and date of birth.

 **When** You may access your ballot between August 16, 2021 and through Election Day, September 14, 2021.
