



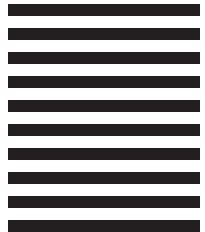

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR NON-UNITED STATES CITIZENS

Any information you provide to the Department of Elections, including your name and address, may be obtained by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and other agencies, organizations, and individuals. In addition, if you apply for naturalization, you will be asked whether you have ever registered or voted in a federal, state, or local election in the United States. You may wish to consult with an immigration attorney, an organization that protects immigrant rights, or other knowledgeable source before providing any personal information to the Department of Elections and before registering to vote in San Francisco Board of Education Elections. You can find a list of nonprofit organizations that specialize in protecting the rights of immigrants on sfelections.org.

Can you use the Non-Citizen Voter Registration Form to register to vote in the School Board election on November 3, 2020?

ALL of the statements below must be true:

- I am not a United States citizen
- I live in San Francisco
- I do not plan to move before November 3, 2020
- I am the parent, or legal guardian or caregiver*, of a child under 19 who lives in San Francisco
- I will be at least 18 years old on November 3, 2020
- I am not in prison or on parole for a felony
- I have not been found mentally incompetent to vote by a court

**A caregiver is someone who signs the affidavit to enroll a minor in school and consents to school-related medical care on behalf of the minor. This is determined by state law, in CA Family Code §6550-6552.*

Registering to vote with the Non-Citizen Voter Registration Form does not permit you to vote in any other federal, state, or local elections.

If someone helped you fill out or deliver the Non-Citizen Voter Registration Form, the person who helped must provide the following information:

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INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. In Section A, review eligibility requirements and complete fields.
2. In Section B, affirm under penalty of perjury that you are eligible to vote in the School Board election and that all information is true and correct. Sign and date.
3. Return this form to the Department of Elections. To return by mail, fold the form to connect the red triangles on the left, and then connect the blue dots. Use tape to seal. To return in person, visit the Department's office in City Hall, Room 48.

All registered voters in San Francisco will be mailed ballots for the November 3 election. In-person voting services will also be available at the voting center and polling places. For information, visit sfelections.org/EDU.

A Eligibility Requirements: I am not a United States citizen; I live in San Francisco; I do not plan to move before November 3, 2020; I will be at least 18 years old on November 3, 2020; I am the parent, legal guardian, or legally recognized caregiver of a child who currently lives in San Francisco and will be under the age of 19 on Election Day, November 3, 2020; I am not in state or federal prison or on parole for a felony; I have not been found mentally incompetent to vote by a court.
