San Francisco's public schools are a disgrace to pupils and the taxpayers who underwrite expenditures.

Enrollment is about 49,500 students, less than half the 1970 enrollment when San Francisco's population was almost 100,000 less than now.

School Board spending has created an enormous deficit. Over one year ago, the state Department of Education ordered the District to prepare a financial recovery plan from an expected deficit over \$100,000,000 in 2022. Only now, with the State ready to assume decision-making over the operation and budget of our schools, is the School Board preparing a plan.

The Board hired several expensive local and out of town law firms to defend itself against three losing lawsuits for violating the open meeting law. These Board members put politics above students when they voted unlawfully to rename 44 schools, cover over historic murals at George Washington High School without obeying the California Environmental Quality Act, and suffered an attorney fee award of \$145,000 while dumbing down admission requirements at Lowell High School. Lowell, a unique, nationally recognized high school with admission based on grades, tests, and essays, has been a multi-year obsession of these unqualified Board members to abandon merit and adopt lottery admissions.

Without merit, Commissioner Collins sued the District and board members for \$87,000,000 costing the District another \$120,000 in legal costs. Instead of seeking reimbursement from Collins, Commissioner Moliga and the Board opted to pay the costs -- effectively leaving less money for classrooms and students. The Board continues to assign pupils to schools outside their own neighborhood schools under a "lottery" system, which with busing, costs taxpayers millions.

For the sake of students and taxpayers, vote to recall Commissioners Collins, Moliga, and Lopez.


