TO THE HONORABLE CHESA BOUDIN, Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the City and County of San Francisco, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of San Francisco District Attorney, and to demand election of a successor in that office. The grounds for the recall are as follows:

Dereliction of duties; malfeasance; egregious waste of taxpayers' funds to the tune of nearly \$400,000/annual compensation; fostering or exacerbating a culture of privileged, incendiary and politicized rhetoric towards the public; distorting of criminal justice data; implementation of a theoretical system of criminal justice which instead agitates and upends our neighborhoods causing crime spikes in every corner of our city. By definition, the public entrusts a District Attorney to prosecute criminals, yet instead every resident, small business owner and visitor to San Francisco has now become a criminal's target, and with near impunity.
