
TO THE HONORABLE GABRIELA LOPEZ: Pursuant to Section 11020 of the California Elections Code and Section 14.103 of the San Francisco Charter, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the City and County of San Francisco, California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Member of the San Francisco Unified School District Board of Education, and to request that the Mayor fill the resulting vacancy and nominate the successor to this office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows: She has been a negligent, ineffective Board of Education Member, who failed to do her job, which is to prioritize our children's education; has mismanaged the District's finances, including not following the Brown Act and other laws, which invites lawsuits that are a waste of money and resources; has failed to prioritize or develop plans for school re-opening; has not provided adequate opportunities for parents and community members to share their concerns on issues including school renaming, school re-opening, and Lowell admissions changes; has failed students with special needs; and has made it more difficult for students from under-privileged backgrounds to obtain a good education, further widening the inequality that exists in our society.

California Elections Code section 11023 provides: (a) Within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, the officer sought to be recalled may file with the elections official, or in the case of a state officer, the Secretary of State, an answer, in not more than 200 words, to the statement of the proponents; (b) If an answer is filed, the officer shall, within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, also serve a copy of it, by personal delivery or by certified mail, on one of the proponents named in the notice of intention; (c) The answer shall be signed and shall be accompanied by the printed name and business or residence address of the officer sought to be recalled.
